**Disposition:** Licensee was charged with a violation of Ala. Code § 34-14A-8 (1975) by engaging in residential home building through an unlicensed entity in violation of Ala. Admin. Code r. 465-X-3-.04(1)(c)3. Prior to the date and time set for a hearing, a settlement was reached. **Licensee agreed to pay a \$2,000 fine and complete six (6) hours of builder education.**
