Prior to the date and time set for a hearing, a settlement was reached. **Licensee agreed to a \$2,500 administrative fine and six (6) hours of builder education.**

Disposition: Licensee was charged with a failure to perform residential homebuilding in a reasonable manner, failure to use a valid written contract, and failure to disclose the status of his general liability insurance in violation of Ala. Code § 34-14A-8 (1975). Prior to the date and time set for a hearing, a settlement was reached. **Licensee agreed to a \$8,000 administrative fine and twelve (12) hours of builder education.**

Disciplinary Action File Number: BC 25-022

Disposition: Licensee was charged with misconduct in the practice of residential home building and performing residential construction outside the scope of its license in violation of Ala. Code § 34-14A-8 (1975). Prior to the date and time set for a hearing, a settlement was reached. **Licensee agreed to a \$7,000 administrative fine and twelve (12) hours of builder education.**
