The Board Takes Unlicensed Builder Activity Seriously.

Since September 25, 2025, the Board has identified and/or stopped the work of 10 unlicensed builders, has sworn three criminal complaint(s), and has prosecuted one unlicensed builder case in district criminal court.

Autauga County District Court, 9/25/2025

Disposition: Unlicensed builder was charged with engaging in the practice of residential homebuilding without holding a current and valid homebuilders license as required by Ala. Code §34-14A-5,14 (1975). Builder pled guilty. Builder was fined \$250.00 Builder received 180 Days suspended sentence and 24 months probation. The builder was also ordered to pay \$6,650.00 restitution.
