Disciplinary Action File Number: CC 24-058

Disposition: Licensee was charged with gross negligence and the failure to perform residential home building in a reasonable manner in violation of Ala. Code § 34-14A-8 (1975). Prior to the date and time set for a hearing, a settlement was reached. **Licensee agreed to a \$10,000 administrative fine and a 45-day suspension.**

Disposition: Licensee was charged with a failure to disclose the status of its general liability insurance, gross negligence and failure to perform residential home building in a reasonable manner in violation of Ala. Code § 34-14A-8 (1975). Prior to the date and time set for a hearing, a settlement was reached. **Licensee agreed to a \$10,000 administrative fine and twelve (12) hours of builder education.**

Disciplinary Action File Number: CC 25-041

Disposition: Licensee was charged with engaging in the business of residential homebuilding outside or beyond the scope of his license, failure to disclose the status of his general liability insurance and misconduct in the practice of residential home building in violation of Ala. Code § 34-14A-8 (1975) and Ala. Code § 34-14A-19 (1975). Prior to the date and time set for a hearing, a settlement was reached. **Licensee agreed to a \$5,000 administrative fine and twelve (12) hours of builder education.**
