By Order of the Home Builders Licensure Board, August 20, 2026

The Board Takes Unlicensed Builder Activity Seriously.

Since 06/25/2026, the Board has identified and/or stopped the work of 18 unlicensed builders, has sworn 2 criminal complaint(s), and has prosecuted 3 unlicensed builder cases in district criminal court.

UB 25-095, Anthony Jeffery Jordan

Madison County District Court, July 15, 2026

Disposition: Unlicensed builder was charged with engaging in the practice of residential homebuilding without holding a current and valid homebuilders license as required by Ala. Code §34-14A-5,14 (1975). Case was Nolle Prossed.

UB 25-099, John Casey Townson

Escambia County District Court, July 20, 2026

Disposition: Unlicensed builder was charged with and pled guilty to engaging in the practice of residential homebuilding without holding a current and valid homebuilders license as required by Ala. Code §34-14A-5,14 (1975). Pled guilty. Sentenced to 12 months in Escambia County Jail, suspended; 24 months unsupervised probation; \$250.00 Bail Bond Fee; \$2,500.00 restitution to homeowner.

UB 25-115, Brandon Hornbuckle

Morgan County District Court, July 22, 2026

Disposition: Unlicensed builder was charged with engaging in the practice of residential homebuilding without holding a current and valid homebuilders license as required by Ala. Code §34-14A-5,14 (1975). Pled guilty. \$10.00 fine; \$100.00 bail bond fee.*
